

## OUTAGAMIE/WINNEBAGO COUNTY COMMUNITY GARDENS

- Approximately 340 adults and children raised a portion of their own food as a result of The Community Garden Partnership.
- Nonprofit food pantries in the area receive regular food donations from the community gardens. Over 700 pounds of produce have been donated each year since 2001.
- Shelters serving in an emergency capacity benefit from community garden food donations that are provided by Master Gardeners and individual gardeners.
- Master Gardeners provide a demonstration garden to serve as an educational model for participating gardeners on at least one of our sites.
- UW-Extension offices act as liaisons between gardeners and the UW system's extensive resources—including pest control, safe food practices, nutritional approaches to gardening, current cultural practices, and environmentally friendly gardening techniques.
- Community gardens provide multiple opportunities for community organizations and businesses, plus strengthen existing partnerships.

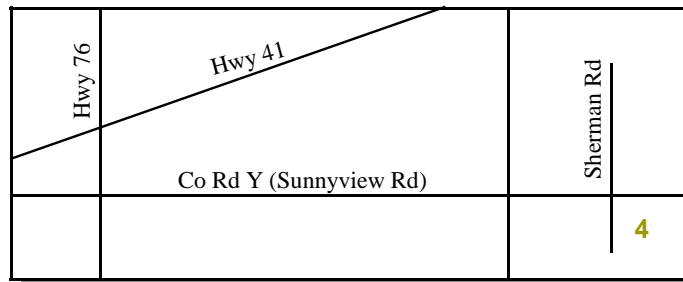
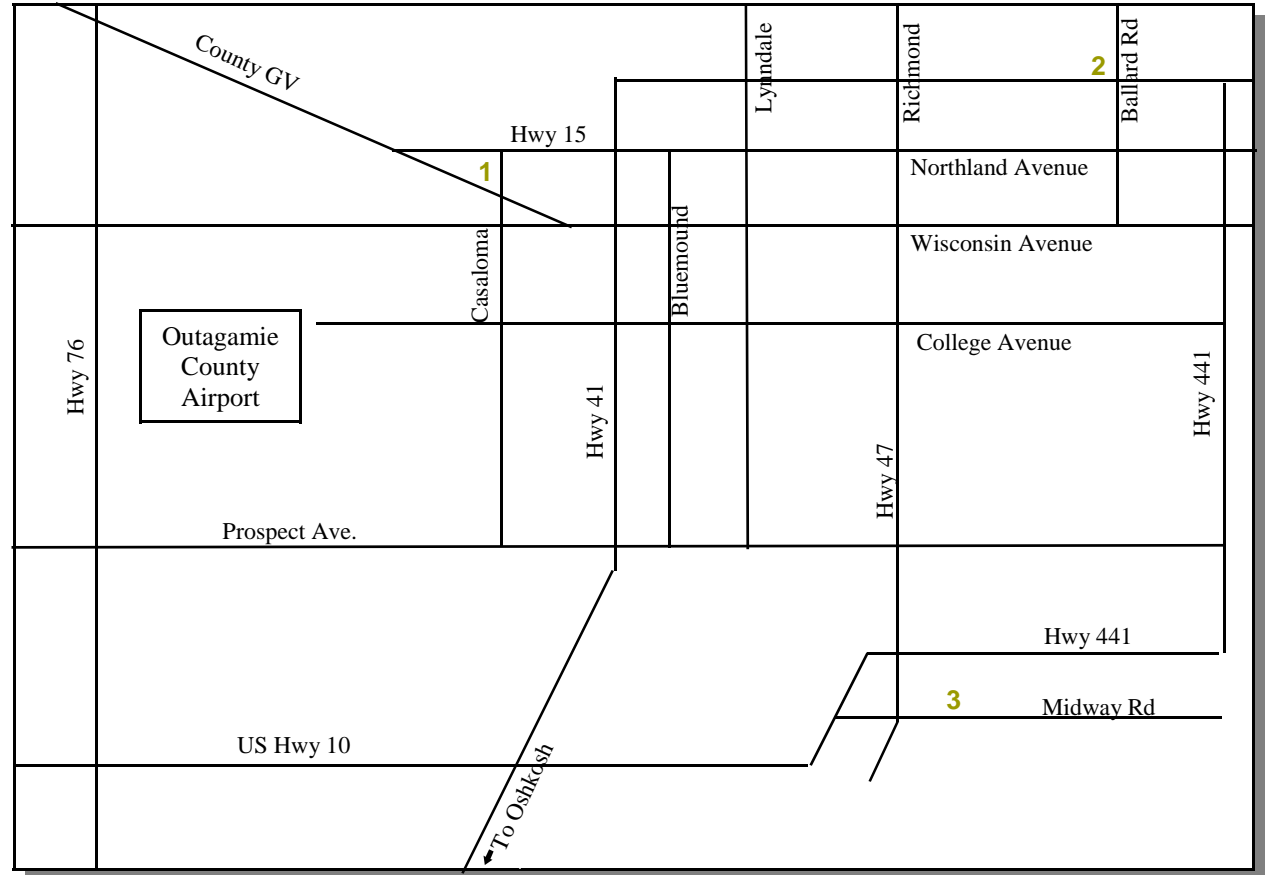
