The need

The Fox Cities Community Clinic was created at the Goodwill Community Center in 1997 to deliver quality, cost-effective health care to individuals whose access to medical services is limited. Staffed by volunteer medical professionals, the Clinic recorded nearly 3,000 patient encounters the first year.

By 2003, Clinic volume had tripled to more than 9,000 patient visits. Economic, insurance, and other cultural trends indicate that by 2006 the demand will grow to 23,000 visits. In short, the facility is inadequate to meet the demands now – and into the future.

The solution: Project Access

Project Access is a community campaign to meet the increasing community need. The \$1.16 million goal includes \$860,000 for Clinic expansion within the Goodwill Community Center and improvements, and \$300,000 start-up funding for four new clinic staff positions.

The renovation will:

- Increase the number of examination rooms from 3 to 12.
- Improve patient privacy with specific consultation areas.
- Provide more space for OB-GYN, mental health and dental care.
- Expand the pharmacy area to enable storage of donated medications.
- Provide multi-purpose space for family consultations and staff development.

The staff positions will include:

- A Medical Director, who will lead chronic disease management and prenatal programs, with on-call and hospital-admitting privileges.
- A certified mental health counselor, who will lead mental health assessment and community service triage activities.
- A business manager to lead patient confidentiality and information systems.
- A Hmong or African American medical assistant to further aid our cultural populations with outreach and medical services.
